Big Brothers Big Sisters (Amachi Program)

Extensive program that offers 1-1 mentorships to youths and young adults to help them recognize and achieve their full potential. This partners children with individuals in the community, including parents and other volunteers, that serve as mentors. They have mentoring programs tailored to each individual's needs.
